Delivering the low latency that IoT applications demand will require a very different network than exists today, particularly at the edge. Virtual CPE and SD-WANs will both play a disruptive role in the development of virtual edge IoT solutions, but what the industry is building toward is Fog Networking, a decentralized and distributed computing infrastructure that will support the requirements for edge analytics and security as service providers and enterprises blend capillary networks of billions of devices into cloud-based systems and networks. To monetize all of that, SPs will need to have a holistic IoT/big data strategy, which may capitalize on technology such as Blockchain, the distributed database and ledger underlying Bitcoin.
